Clinical Interest/Focus

*Dr. Hall-Schwarz believes symptoms are
signals received from both the conscious
and unconscious mind, from various
sources throughout the body.*

*This is often an indication that
something is wrong. By avoiding these
indicators, clients with extending and
spiraling issues are often certain to end up
in a complex and convoluted crises. By
collaborating and developing a trusting
relationship with clients, it is possible to
maximize understanding and allow
relaxation — thus, having the opportunity
where the body may release its own
natural healing abilities.*

*In today's society, it is obvious that our
weaknesses or problems (such as anger,
insecurity, fear of intimacy, the need to
control) are all expressions of a wounded
child within.*

*Much of our society has been wounded
to some degree through abuse or
dysfunctional families that often leaves
behind unresolved issues.*

*Many conflicts tend to carry over into
our adult functioning, romantic
relationships, parenting, even in our
career. Through a trusting relationship, Dr.
Hall Schwarz utilizes an integrative
approach with issues of interest, including
marital and relational issues, remarriage-
blended families, divorce, relocation, court
cases, depression, anxiety, self-esteem
issues, communication, stress, life
transitions, abuse, trauma, grief, career,
women's issues, loneliness and
abandonment, and bereavement.*
